Dear Customer.

Integra LifeSciences has identified through a limited number of complaints that the speaker in the CAM02/LCX02/LCX02R monitors may potentially malfunction and if this occurs, the monitors will stop providing an audible tone at start-up or at alarm points during use.

For neurocritical care applications, this does not affect the ability of the monitor to provide the signals for these tones and alarms to the bedside monitor at all times. When it is connected to a bedside monitor (available only for neurocritical care applications), the monitor will provide the tones and alarms as identified in the Chapter 3 of the CAM02 User's Manual or Chapter 4 of the LCX02 User's Manual. A corrective action to eliminate the potential speaker malfunction has been identified and is currently being verified for implementation. Once verified, Integra will contact you with instructions to implement the corrective action.

There has not been any report of a patient injury or adverse health consequences as a result of such a failure. In light of the above, **Integra is initiating this field safety notice to be confident you have the ability to hear the audible tones and alarms.**

We recommend you follow the instructions below:

- 1) For neurocritical care applications, where a bedside monitor is available for use, connect it to that monitor as identified in Chapter 3 of the CAM02 User's Manual and Chapter 4 of the LCX02 User's Manual. If you require a PMIO cable or adapter for your bedside monitor, please contact your local customer service Integra at +44(0)126.4312.725.
- 2) Where a bedside monitor is not available for use:

For CAM02: Check the continued function of the speaker on an hourly basis by decreasing the High ICP Alarm Limit to a value that is lower than the patient's displayed Mean ICP value (e.g. 15 mmHg). This will trigger the high ICP alarm after 5 seconds. Once the speaker emits the alarm tone, change the High ICP Alarm Limit back to the desired level. If the speaker does not emit the alarm tone, we recommend you stop using the monitor and contact your local customer service Integra at +44(0)126.4312.725. For detailed instructions on setting the high ICP alarm limit, refer to chapter 4 of the User's Manual.

For LCX02/LCX02R: Check the continued function of the speaker on an hourly basis by increasing the PtO2 Alarm Limit to a value that is higher than the patient's displayed PtO2 value (e.g. 30 mmHg). This will trigger the low PtO2 alarm if the patient's displayed PtO2 value remains below the Low PtO2 Alarm Limit for more than 5 seconds. Once the speaker emits the alarm tone, change the Low PtO2 Alarm Limit back to the desired level. If the speaker does not

- 3) When performing start-up of the CAM02, LCX02 and LCX02R monitors according to the User's Manual, absence of a tone indicates that the speaker is not working. If a tone is heard during start-up, please keep in mind that the speaker can fail during use. If a tone is not heard at start-up or at any expected time and you do not have the ability to connect to a bedside monitor, we recommend you stop using the monitor and contact your local customer service Integra at +44(0)126.4312.725.
