Round, white, biplanar tablets with bevelled edge. Scored on one side with 'GU' above and '2.5' below the score.

Product imported from Italy

Round, white, tablets. Scored on one side with 'Gutron' and a star symbol on the other side.

The score line is only to facilitate breaking for ease of swallowing and not to divide into equal doses.
