

Outcome of the Process - Public Consultation on Proposed Human Medicines, Compliance, Medical Devices and Veterinary Medicines Fees for 2022

1 RESPONSE TO THE CONSULTATION

The HPRA received no responses on the Human Medicines, Compliance fees and Medical Device fee consultation and no responses on the Veterinary Medicines consultation. We believe that the reason that we received no responses reflects the HPRA's commitment to maintain fees for 2022 at the same level as previous years.

2 CONCLUSION

The HPRA's primary objective is the protection of public health but in delivering this we are committed to providing a first class service to the industry we regulate. We will continue to review the cost base of the HPRA and related fees. As always we commit to reviewing our fees annually to ensure that the fee levels are appropriate to the functions and costs of the HPRA.

Consequently, as no responses were received, we propose to submit the fee structure as outlined in the original consultation document to the Minister for Health and the Minister for Agriculture, Food and the Marine for approval.
