<b>Indication for use</b>	<p>Treatment of flea (<i>Ctenocephalides</i> spp.) and tick (<i>Ixodes ricinus</i>, <i>Rhipicephalus sanguineus</i>) infestations in dogs and cats.</p> <p>Treatment of biting lice infestations in dogs (<i>Trichodectes canis</i>) and cats (<i>Felicola subrostratus</i>).</p> <p>The product can be used as part of a treatment strategy for Flea Allergy Dermatitis (FAD) where this has been previously diagnosed by a veterinary surgeon.</p> <p>Insecticidal efficacy against new infestations with adult fleas persists for up to 2 months in cats and up to 3 months in dogs, depending on environmental challenge.</p> <p>The product has a persistent acaricidal efficacy for up to 4 weeks against ticks, depending on the level of environmental challenge.</p>
